Notice of Race

The Regatta will be conducted under the authority of the Point Leo Boat Club Inc. The regatta will be conducted on Westernport on Sunday 19 January 2025.

1. Rules

1.1 The regatta shall be governed by the rules as defined in the World Sailing Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), Australian Sailing (AS) Special Regulations and the ILCA and Impulse Class Rules, except as any of these are changed by the sailing instructions.

1.2 RRS Appendix T "Arbitration" will apply.

2. Eligibility

2.1 The object of the Regatta is to bring together as many ILCA and Impulse sailing members of Westernport yacht clubs as possible for mutual enjoyment and friendly competition.

2.1 The Regatta is open to all ILCA and Impulse Class Dinghies provided the person in charge is a member of a club previously affiliated with Yachting Westernport. Each competitor must be a financial member of a yacht club.

2.4 All boats shall comply with AS Special Regulations Part 2 for off the beach boats

2.6 Boats shall be insured with valid 3rd party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$5,000,000 million dollars (preferably \$10,000,000) per incident.

3. Fees

3.1 Required fees are as follows:

4. Schedule of Races and Events

4.1 It is intended to run 2 or 3 back-to-back races with the first warning signal for the first race at 13:00.

5. Sailing Instructions

5.1 The sailing instructions will be available on Point Leo Boat Club website.

6. Entry

6.1 Entries can be submitted on the morning of Sunday 19th January 2025 or with the start boat if sailing over. Entries will be available online on the Point Leo Boat Club website.

7. Scoring System

8.1 The Low Point scoring system, Appendix A.4 will apply.

8. Liability

8.1 All those taking part in this regatta do so at their own risk. Point Leo Boat Club accepts no liability for material damage, personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with, prior to, during or after the event. Attention is drawn to RRS 3.

9. Course

9.3 The course will be defined in the sailing instructions.
